RE-ENTRY

The re-entry visa allows foreign nationals who are legally residing in Italy and hold a residence card or permit—but who happen to be temporarily without such documents (due to theft, loss, etc.)—to enter the country in order to continue a long-term stay, whether for a fixed or indefinite period, and intend to re-enter Italian territory, or to foreign nationals whose residence permit has expired (no more than 60 days ago), subject to the opinion of the competent Italian police headquarters (Questura).

To apply for a visa, you must submit:

- 1) a residence visa application form, duly completed and signed;
- 2) a valid passport with an expiration date at least 15 months beyond the duration of the stay;
- 3) a recent ICAO-format photo;
- 4) a report of theft or loss filed with the competent local police authorities;
- 5) a statement from the foreign national confirming their right to continue their long-term stay in Italy;
- 6) Receipt for payment of consular fees, in accordance with the procedures established by the Italian diplomatic-consular mission with jurisdiction over the territory;
- 7) Copy of the national internal passport (page containing personal information and page with the residence stamp).
