SEA TRANSIT

A transit visa allows a foreign national to travel through the territory of the contracting parties during a journey from one third country to another third country, and is granted on the condition that the foreign national is guaranteed entry into the final destination country and that the route must reasonably require transit through the territory of the other contracting parties.

To apply for a visa, you must submit:

- 1) a residence visa application form, duly completed and signed;
- 2) a passport valid for at least three months beyond the duration of your stay;
- 3) a recent ICAO-format photo;
- 4) a copy of your most recent Schengen visas;
- 5) A formal request from the shipping company;
- 6) Confirmation of the vessel's presence in the port of destination issued by the competent Italian port authority;
- 7) A seaman's passport issued by the competent Russian authorities;
- 8) A receipt for payment of consular fees, in accordance with the procedures established by the Italian diplomatic-consular mission with jurisdiction over the territory;
- 9) A copy of your national ID card (the page with your personal information and the page with the residence stamp).
- 10) Health insurance providing a minimum coverage of €30,000 for medical expenses, emergency hospitalization, and repatriation costs.
