TRANSPORT

The transport visa allows entry, for the purpose of a short-term stay, to foreign nationals who intend to travel to Italy for brief periods to carry out professional activities related to the transport of goods or people, whether by land or air (truck drivers, charter flight crews, or private flight crews).

To apply for a visa, you must submit:

- 1) a residence visa application form, duly completed and signed;
- 2) a passport valid for at least three months beyond the duration of your stay;
- 3) a recent ICAO-format photo;
- 4) documentazione attestante la condizione professionale del richiedente;
- 5) Documentation pertaining to the activities to be carried out during the requested stay;
- 6) A valid commercial driver's license for heavy vehicles;
- 7) Valid motor vehicle liability insurance for the vehicle used for travel.
- 8) Travel health insurance, valid for the entire duration of the visa, providing a minimum coverage of 30,000.00 euros for emergency hospitalization expenses and repatriation costs;
- 9) ASMAP request letter specifying the purpose, duration, and frequency of the trips;
- 10) Receipt of payment of consular fees, in accordance with the procedures established by the Italian diplomatic-consular mission with jurisdiction over the territory;
- 11) Copy of the national internal passport (page with personal information and page with the residence stamp).
